

Declaration on information obligation (Data protection declaration)

Protection of your personal data is a special concern to us. We therefore process your data exclusively on the basis of legal provisions (DSGVO, TKG [Telecommunications Act] 2003). In this data protection information, we inform you about the most important aspects of data processing as part of our website.

Using our website is generally possible without providing any personal data. Insofar as our sites collect personal data (for example, name, address or email address), this information is always provided on a voluntary basis, whenever possible. This data is not forwarded to third parties without your express approval.

Contact us

If you contact us by email, post or fax, we save the data provided by you for processing purposes and for follow-up questions. This data shall not be passed on without your consent. However we must mention that the data transfer via internet (for example, in case of communication by email) may be subject to security breaches. A seamless data protection against access by third parties is not possible.

Cookies

Our website uses the so-called Cookies. It refers to small text files which are archived on your device with the help of browsers. They cause you no harm.

We use Cookies to make our offer user-friendly. Some Cookies remain saved on your device until you delete them. They enable us to recognise your browser the next time you visit the site. If you do not want this, you may set your browser such that it informs you about the Cookies setting and allows you only on a case-by-case basis. By deactivating Cookies the functionality of our website can be restricted.

Server-Log-Files

The provider of sites gathers and saves information automatically in the so-called server log files that transfers your browser automatically to us. These are:

Time of server request

This data cannot be assigned to specific persons. An integration of this data with other data sources is not carried out. We reserve the right to inspect this data subsequently if we come to know of any concrete evidence for an illegal use.

Your rights
